NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A REGULAR WINDCREST CITY COUNCIL MEETING WILL BE HELD AT WINDCREST CITY HALL, 8601 MIDCROWN, WINDCREST, TEXAS ON THE 5th DAY OF FEBRUARY 2018 STARTING AT 6:00 P.M. DURING THE MEETING THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS WILL BE CONSIDERED AND THE COUNCIL MAY TAKE ACTION ON ANY OF THE LISTED SUBJECTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL RESERVES THE OPTION TO RECESS THE MEETING DURING THE EVENING OF FEBRUARY 5, 2018 AND TO RECONVENE THE MEETING ON THE FOLLOWING DAY, FEBRUARY 6, 2018 AT 9:00 A.M. AT THE WINDCREST CITY HALL, 8601 MIDCROWN, WINDCREST, TEXAS.

IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT MEMBERS OF OTHER CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES MAY ATTEND THE MEETING IN NUMBERS THAT MAY CONSTITUTE A QUORUM OF SUCH OTHER CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES, SO THAT NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE MEETING IS ALSO A MEETING OF THE OTHER CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES WHOSE MEMBERS ARE IN ATTENDANCE. THE MEMBERS OF THE OTHER CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES MAY PARTICIPATE IN DISCUSSIONS WHICH OCCUR AT THE MEETING, BUT NO ACTION WILL BE TAKEN BY THE OTHER BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES WHOSE MEMBERS ARE IN ATTENDANCE.

REQUEST ALL PAGERS AND CELL PHONES BE TURNED OFF, EXCEPT EMERGENCY ON-CALL PERSONNEL. CITIZENS ARE ASKED TO REFRAIN FROM TALKING DURING COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS.

Ordinance No. 2016-618B(O) establishes certain protocols for City Council meetings.

At all City Council, City Commission or City Board meetings, the agenda shall include a "citizens to be heard" item. It is suggested that Citizens wishing to speak during this item sign in on the sign up roster prior to the meeting. During "Citizens to be Heard", citizens may address the City Council on topics not on the agenda for no more than three (3) minutes. In addition to the foregoing, citizens shall also have the opportunity to address the City Council during consideration of posted agenda items for no more than six (6)

minutes. Each citizen shall therefore have the opportunity to address the City Council for a total of nine (9) minutes. This does not include any responses from the body. The six (6) minutes time limit authorized herein may not be transferred to another speaker in whole or in part. The presiding Officer or his/her designee will assign a Time Keeper to each meeting. The Time Keeper will maintain strict compliance of the six (6) minute rule, stopping speakers who exceed the allotted time. As authorized by Section 551.042 of the Texas Government Code, a city official may make a statement of specific factual information in response to an inquiry made by a member of the public or a recitation of existing city policy. Any deliberation or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting. Any question posed by a Citizen, Council Member, Board Member or Commission Member for which an answer is not available at a meeting shall be answered by a member of the staff or Presiding Officer at the next regular meeting of the Body, if an answer is reasonably available and prudent. If the information is sensitive, staff will seek advice from the City Attorney.

Meeting Chair: please remind each participant in your meeting that they must speak into a microphone; the recording is the Official Minutes of your meeting and all who speak must be recorded. All guest speakers and citizens to be heard must speak from podium. Please interrupt speakers during meeting if you recognize that they are not speaking into microphone and have them do so.

I. Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, Invocation and Announcement

II. Citizens to be Heard

1. Citizens may address the City Council on topics not on the agenda for no more than three (3) minutes.
2. In addition to the foregoing, citizens shall also have the opportunity to address the City Council during consideration of posted agenda items for no more than six (6) minutes.
3. A City Official may make a statement of specific factual information in response to an inquiry made by a member of the public, or a recitation of existing policy in response to an inquiry made by a member of the public.

III. Ordinances *“In conjunction with the first reading of an ordinance, a motion should be made to either “reject the proposed ordinance” or “to forward the proposed ordinance to a subsequent City Council meeting for final adoption at its second reading”.**

City Council will review, discuss and may take action on Ordinance 2018-618F(O), an ordinance amending Ordinance 618B enacted on February 1, 2016 by changing the Regular City Council Meeting schedule. (Att. 1) **Second Reading**

IV. Submission of Referendum

The City Secretary will submit the certified referendum petition concerning the creation of the Windcrest Volunteer Fire Department Bugle Crew and enforcement of Section 12, Article III of the Windcrest Code of Ordinances to the City Council. The City Council may consider a resolution calling an election for the referendum on May 5, 2018.

V. General Announcements & Future Agenda Items Requested

Per Ordinance No. 618, repealing Ordinance No. 593; Section 9: Every agenda shall include an item entry granting a member the opportunity to propose an item for consideration of future agendas for Regular or Special Meetings. Any member may request the inclusion of such items at any meeting.

VI. Adjournment

The City Council reserves the right to retire into executive session whenever it is considered necessary and legally justified under the Texas Government Code, Subchapter D, Sections 551.071 et. seq. including, but not limited to, consultation with attorney, real property, prospective gifts, personnel matters, exclusion of witness, security devices, and economic development matters.

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-618F(O)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 618B ENACTED ON FEBRUARY 1, 2016 BY CHANGING THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 618B was enacted on February 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 618B, Section 1 provides for regular City Council meetings on the first and third Mondays of each month; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 618E was enacted on January 9, 2017 changing the starting time for regular City Council meetings to 6:00pm; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to change the regular meeting dates to the third Monday of each month with a starting time of 6:00pm.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINDCREST, TEXAS that Ordinance 618B is amended by revising the first sentence of Section 1 pertaining to meet schedules to read as follows:

“Regular City Council Meetings shall be held on the third Monday of each month at 6:00 pm in the City Council Chambers”.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and the City Secretary shall cause a copy of it to be made available on the city website.
