SUBJECT: Handgun Purchase

SUMMARY: The Windcrest Police Department currently is using the Glock Model 22 Gen 3 .40 cal pistols which have been in use for over 10 years. Recommended replacement should be considered at 8 years. This purchase will bring replace the current handguns with the Glock Model 22 Gen 4 .40 cal pistols.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The handguns currently in use by the Windcrest Police Department have been in service for over 10 years. This is due to the exposure to the elements as well as the wear and tear of the weapons on a daily basis.

ISSUE: Police officers carry these weapons exposed to the elements on a daily basis. They are subjected to rain, sun, heat and cold throughout their work day. Even though the weapons are all functioning there comes a time where they need to be cycled out and replaced with new weapons.

ALTERNATIVES: Considering officer safety, there is really not much of an alternative.

FISCAL IMPACT: The funding for this project will come out of the WCCPD budget capital expenses and totals \$13,611.40. However, our plans are to get approximately \$8,793.00 back for the current weapons for a total cost of approximately \$4,666.40. The money for the current weapons will be placed back into the WCCPD fund that it came from.

This ordinance authorizes the purchase of 30 Glock Model 22 Gen 4 .40 Cal pistols.

RECOMMENDATION:

The police department recommends approval of the purchase of these weapons.
